CLIMATE & WINE SYMPOSIUM

THE CONTEXT

The wine community is the canary in the coal mine for climate change. Fires, heat spikes, drought, atmospheric rivers are increasing in frequency & intensity. Coming together as climate action leaders is no longer optional, it is imperative.

We make one of the highest value agricultural crops. We have a powerful platform to galvanize change. We can build more resilient vineyards, businesses & communities, secure consumer loyalty, and set a leadership standard that drives global action and impact.

WHY RISE?

In Spring 2025 Napa Green will host the 3rd biennial RISE Symposium. In 2023, RISE brought together 70 speakers, 750 guests, and 40 sponsors. RISE has led to the formation of a Watershed Restoration Coalition, a Zero Waste Collective, vineyards going herbicide–free, wineries lightening glass weight and greening packaging. RISE is for anyone in the wine community committed to positive, near-term action.

Collectively, unified under a common goal, we can harness our opportunities and influence to serve as a force to transform the wine, agriculture and beverage sectors.



THE CHANGEMAKING

This two-week series of six half-day events is designed to accelerate meaningful sustainability and climate action transformation across the entire community and culture of wine. The events are organized around the **Six Pillars of Sustainable Winegrowing Leadership**:

APRIL 29 - WATER EFFICIENCY & SAVINGS


APRIL 30 - ENERGY EFFICIENCY & SAVINGS

MISSION STATEMENT


To establish the first whole systems series of events, paired with sustained support and mentorship, that will not only inspire and educate, but facilitate and accelerate critical mass action.


HOW IS THIS DIFFERENT?


